- Leader of the Army of Northern Virginia
- Won all five battles of the Seven Days in the beginning of the war
- Made a "fight against" Lee
- Opposed secession but did not believe the war would be won

Critical Civil War Developments and Battles

3rd - The signing of the Emancipation Proclamation made "freeing the slaves" the new focus of the war

5th - The Battle of Gettysburg was the turning point of the war; the North repulsed Lee's invasion

6th - Lee's surrender to Grant at Appomattox Court House in 1865 ended the war
