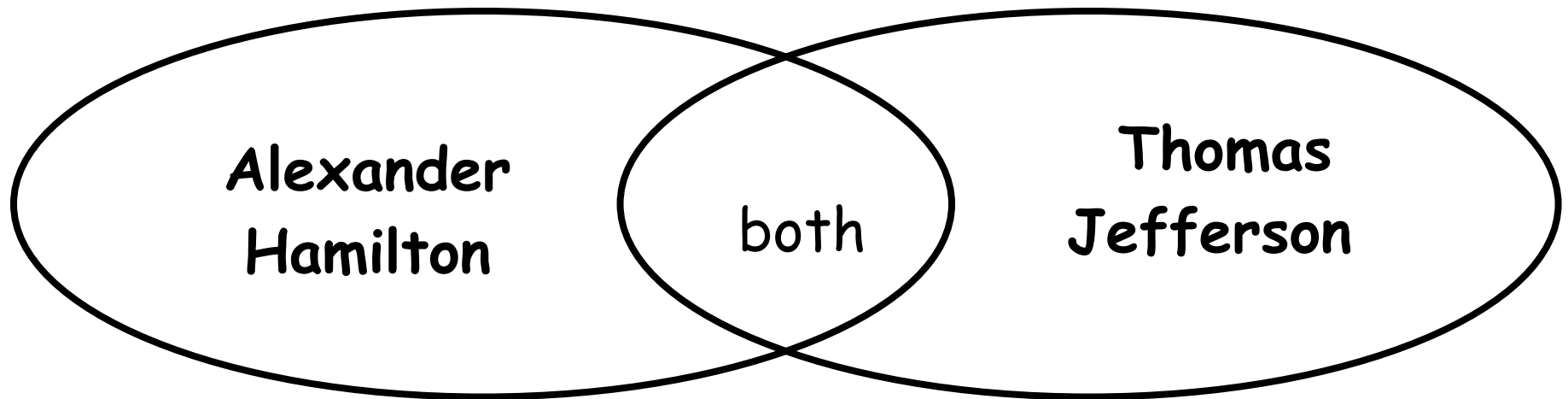


US 1.7c Identify conflicts that resulted in the emergence of two political parties

Emergence of Two Political Parties



Teaching Tips: Fold paper in $\frac{1}{2}$, hotdog fold, leaving a 2" flap exposed. Glue title to the top flap of a foldable. Glue Venn diagram to the top layer. Cut the top layer in thirds.

Under flaps, students include the major party differences under either Alexander Hamilton or Thomas Jefferson. (See page 28 of the *Curriculum Framework* for a fact list). Under the middle section labeled "both", list things in common with both parties, such as started by the founding fathers, believing in democracy, forming political parties, etc.
